Paint your own Easter egg

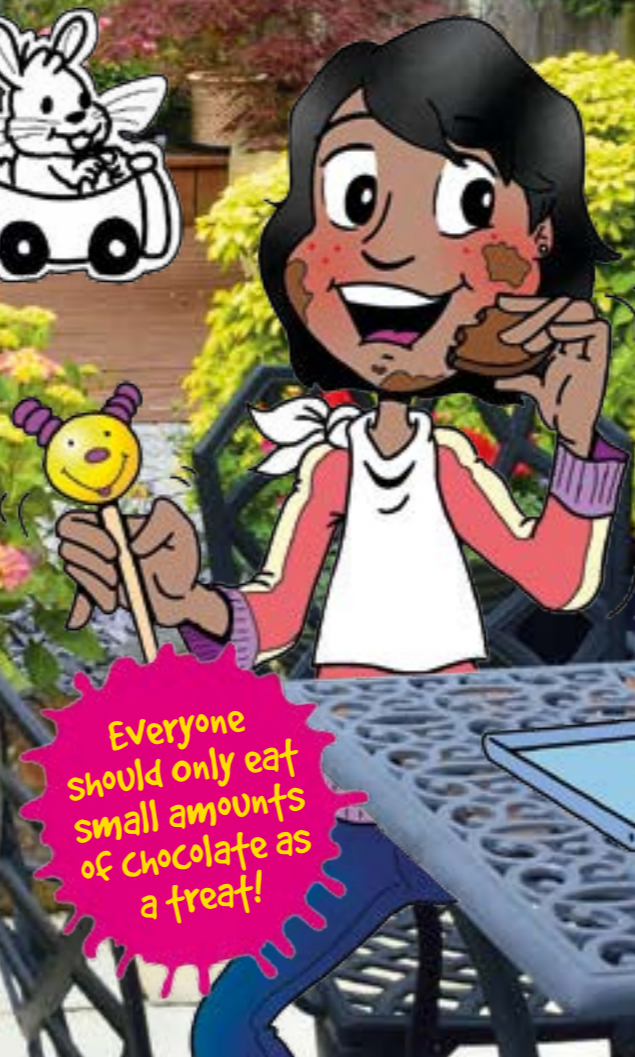
- 1 Fill a saucepan with water and boil the egg – get a grown-up to help you with this.
- 2 Cool the egg in cold water to stop it cooking.
- 3 Fill a cup with 1 teaspoon of food colouring – any colour you like!
- 4 Dip and design! Place the egg in the colour you want and once it's dry, use crayons to add extra art!

Make an Easter tree

- 1 Find some nice twigs or sticks in the garden.
- 2 Ask a grown-up to help you paint the twigs or sticks white. (Make sure you wash your hands afterwards.)
- 3 After the paint has dried, hang little ready-decorated eggs on the twigs or sticks – like decorations on a Christmas tree – and arrange in a vase.



Fun fact!
The tallest chocolate Easter egg was made in Italy in 2011. At over 10m high and weighing 7,200kg, it was taller than a giraffe and heavier than an elephant!
